

Caring for Your Jacuzzi with Bromine

Upon fill up:

1. Add 2oz of **Sodium Bromide** directly to water
2. Insert **Jacuzzi Proclear Cartridge** into filter or onto filter basket
3. Pour one half (250 gallon spas or less) or one full bottle (250+ gallon spas) of **Metal Gon** directly into water
4. Add 2 oz. of **Renew** directly into water
5. Add 2 oz. of **Defender** directly into water
6. Wait at least 12 hours and check Ph with **Test Strip**
7. Adjust Ph as necessary with **Spa Up** or **Spa Down**
8. Place 1-3 1" Bromine Tablets in skimmer next to filter(s)

Thursday Maintenance:

1. Add 2 oz. of **Defender** directly to water
2. Check and add **Bromine Tablets** as necessary

Sunday Maintenance:

1. Check Ph with **Test Strip** and adjust as necessary
2. Add 2 oz. (per 250 gallons) of **Renew** directly to water
3. Check and add **Bromine Tablets** as necessary

Weekly or as needed:

1. Add 2 oz. of **Bright & Clear** if water is cloudy
2. Add 2 oz. of **Enzyme** if spa develops a scum line around water
3. Add 2 oz. of **Foam Down** if water is excessively foamy
4. Spray out filters with high pressure garden hose

Monthly:

1. Apply **Cover Care & Conditioner** to cover to protect from UV rays
2. Remove filters from the spa. Spray down with **Instant Cartridge Clean**, let soak 20 minutes in the shade (so they don't dry), rinse filters thoroughly and reinstall into spa.

Every 3-4 Months:

1. Drain spa and wipe down shell with a cotton towel. Once dry, apply a thin layer of **Fast Gloss** to the shell, allow 15 minutes to dry, and wipe off with a clean cotton towel. Spray out shell and use a wet/dry vacuum to remove any remaining Fast Gloss left on the shell.
2. Dilute one bottle of **Filter Clean** in four gallons of water and allow filters to soak for at least three hours. Rinse filters thoroughly and reinstall into spa.
3. Refill spa and refer to the Upon fill up portion above

For spas 250 gallons or less, adjust all 2 oz. measurements to 1 oz.
Whenever removing filters from the hot tub, be sure there is nothing in the spa that can be pulled in the plumbing lines under the filters.
